- Influence Governments/Ministers of Health to participate in and designate funds for national blindness prevention programmes
- Educate target audiences about blindness prevention, about VISION 2020 and to generate support for VISION 2020 programme activities

International Key Messages

- 36 million people (http://atlas.iapb.org/global-burden-vision-impairment/) who are blind
- <u>217 million people (http://atlas.iapb.org/global-burden-vision-impairment/)</u> with moderate or severe distance vision impairment
- Of those with blindness and MSVI, <u>124 million people have uncorrected refractive errors and 65 million have cataract (http://atlas.iapb.org/global-burden-vision-impairment/gbvi-global-cause-estimates/)</u>—more than 75% of all blindness and MSVI is avoidable
- 253 million people blind or vision impaired (in 2015)
